Dear Parents

I hope that the last week has been as positive as it could be given the extreme circumstances and that you and your family are safe and well.

I indicated that at the end of last week I would be in touch with further details of the Remote Learning Provision for the period of time while the school remains closed. Anthony Fobel, our Chair of Governors will be writing to you at the start of next week to provide a specific update on the fee situation for next term following recent discussions at governor level.

It is clear that we are going to require a framework for remote learning that is sustainable for what potentially could be an extended period of time. The document attached provides an outline of the nature and scope of the Remote Learning Provision to be delivered throughout the period that The Hall is closed.

Thank you for the many comments sent in during the last week of term in relation to the boys' first experiences of working remotely from home. The SLT and I have been working this week to ensure that we have ready a coherent and appropriate provision that is functional to meet the needs of boys across each year group going forwards.

I hope that you find this document to be self-explanatory but please be assured that further guidance will be provided before the start of the new term and on a regular basis. You will see that we aim to keep many of the school's day-to-day events functioning to ensure that as far as possible we provide as much continuity and stability for everyone. This also applies to events and information meetings for parents about which I will be in touch at the start of term with further details. I also anticipate being able to hold all my scheduled parent meetings via phone or other platforms.

While it may be difficult at this time to focus on the positive, I hope that within the next two weeks you will find time and space to enjoy being with your families and to find some 'silver linings' amongst the clouds.
