Cookie Policy

What is a cookie?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. These pieces of information are used to make the website work or improve services for you through, for example enabling a service to recognise your device so you don't have to give the same information several times during one task.

On The Hall's website we sometimes embed video and sound content from websites such as Vimeo and Soundcloud. As a result, when you visit a page with such embedded content, you may be presented with cookies from these websites. We do not control the dissemination of these cookies. You should check the relevant third party website for more information about these signposted below.

Can I control or delete cookies?

All recent versions of popular browsers (such as Edge, Internet Explorer, Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox) allow you to control cookies. Typically, you can set your browser to accept or reject all, or certain cookies. You might, for example, be happy to accept a cookie that allows you to log in to a website but prefer to reject any which are used to build a profile of your internet usage. You should also be able to set your browser to prompt you each time a cookie is offered.

Please be aware that restricting cookies may impact on the functionality of this website.

- **Apt.uid-** used by GainSight. The purpose of this cookie is to allow persistent ID tracking under the top-level domain of the product and is used as a reference ID to the user entity.
- **Zlcmid-** used by ZenDesk. **Zopim Cookies** is the live chat software provided by Zendesk and it utilises cookies to help identify a user's chat session between page loads
